

## **Terms and Conditions of the Noni Gasa Bursary**

- Applications must be submitted via [www.designacademyoffashion.com](http://www.designacademyoffashion.com)
- Applications are open to South African citizens between the ages of 18 and 30 only.
- Applicable to Diploma students only, enrolling for First Year in February 2020.
- All participants must be eligible to study a Diploma (as per their National Senior Certificate). Applicants must submit their National Senior Certificate to Design Academy of Fashion as soon as they receive it.
- Should the students not have met the minimum requirements for entrance into the program applied for, the student will forfeit their application.
- The bursary beneficiary has one week to confirm acceptance of the bursary as well as all prerequisites laid out in the terms & conditions. Thereafter they are required to submit their registration forms within one week of acceptance to secure their place at Design Academy of Fashion for 2020.
- In order to continue on the bursary program, the winning student must successfully pass the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> levels.
- The Noni Gasa Bursary candidate must complete their studies in no more than 3 years (36 months) for the Diploma in Fashion.
- Should the beneficiary fail or drop out of the program, they will be held liable for the full year's fees.
- Bursary students are ambassadors of DAF and as such are required to act in an acceptable and respectable manner. This includes but is not limited to passing all modules, submitting assignments by the required deadlines, class punctuality and acceptable attendance of lectures presented.

- Bursary includes full tuition fees for 3 years, R5 000 towards living expenses, R1 000 per month from Woolworths Food (36 months), unlimited mobile data from Rain (36 months), Art Kit, Sewing Kit, Elna sewing machine & Elna overlocker.
- Bursary students are ambassadors of DAF and as such are required to act in an acceptable and respectable manner. This includes but is not limited to passing all modules, submitting assignments by the required deadlines, class punctuality and acceptable attendance of lectures presented.
- Bursary students are also expected to act in line with DAF's Policies and Procedures and the student's code of conduct laid out in the institutional handbook.
